# IRAQ- Tikrit

Hi! BADDIES,

It's been awhile since I have seen you all. So I thought I'd update ya'll on what's been going on with me. On 6 JUN 04 I was activated to go back over to the Middle East for Operation Iraqi Freedom. I spent the first five Months training in FT. Dix New Jersey. Before we left New Jersey we had the chance to take block leave. I took my Leave in Florida to see my MOM who was terminally ill with Cancer. It was a good time being with her. While in Florida I Had a chance to do some diving and also had a chance to try spear fishing for the first time. Needless to say I loved it. So of course as the typical SCUBA Diver I felt I needed a new toy so I bought a spear gun, which I'll pick up from my step-father in Florida and bring back to Texas when I return from the Middle East. After Block leave we left for Kuwait 12 NOV 04. We stayed in Kuwait till 6 Jan 05. At this time we headed north to IRAQ. I am now stationed near the town of Tikrit, which is just north of Baghdad. The base I am on is called Camp Spiecher. We do at times get some excitement her but for the most part it is relatively tame around here. During the tour you usually get to take a mid tour leave, but unfortunately I won't be able to since I had to take emergency Leave back in December. On the other hand they do have it set up where we get to go on an RR Pass to take a four day break. We will get one or two of these while were here. In the meantime I am planning out my boat I plan to buy when I get back to the states. I'm looking to get a 22ft Sea Chaser Bay Boat with a Yamaha 150 Four Stroke outboard motor when I come home so I can do some more Diving and Relaxing on My own Boat. As far as what I do here I work in Communications Security. I'm in charge of all my Battalions Encryption that goes in our aircrafts Radio's. So that's pretty much what I do here. Along with this e-mail I am going to send a few pictures of where we work and live, both in Kuwait and IRAQ. As far as when I'll be coming back it should be around mid to Late November 05'. If anyone would like to write me I'll leave you my snail mail address and e-mail address. I hope everyone is doing ok and I look forward to seeing you all again.




