## Ginger-Citrus Grouper

### FISH

- 1 1/2 lb. grouper fillets
- 4 teaspoons grated fresh ginger
- 1 teaspoon grated lime peel
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil



### VINAIGRETTE

- 6 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons orange juice
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground pepper

1. Heat oven to 350°F. Rub one side of each grouper fillet with ginger and lime peel; sprinkle with 1/4 teaspoon salt and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Place flour in shallow bowl. Dip fish in flour; lightly shake off excess.

2. Heat large ovenproof skillet over high heat until hot. Add oil; heat until hot. Add fish, seasoned side down; cook 3 to 4 minutes or until golden brown, turning once. Place in oven; bake 6 to 8 minutes or until fish just begins to flake.

3. Meanwhile, place all vinaigrette ingredients in blender; blend until combined. Drizzle over each serving plate; top with fish

Breaking the record proved a challenge when some divers struggled to sink with their surprisingly buoyant ironing boards. But they succeeded and raised \$865 for reef protection.

## Dead zones regularly haunt coast

**A&M**

**study finds low-oxygen areas near Texas not rare phenomena**

Low-oxygen waters known as dead zones have appeared as regularly as the tides along the Texas coast, according to a new Texas A&M University study.

Although the first report of a dead zone off Texas came in 1979, researchers now believe the condition has repeated itself annually for at least 23 years and will likely continue — not unlike the lethal cycle that has threatened fish and shrimp in the waters off Louisiana for decades.

The cause is probably the slurry of soil that flows out of several rivers and into the Gulf of Mexico, but A&M oceanographer Steve DiMarco said more water-quality studies are needed.

DiMarco analyzed samples of Texas coastal waters and found that oxygen-starved dead zones have formed between the Louisiana border and Brownsville in all but one year since 1985, the oldest data available.

## Four sharks found dead at Moody Gardens Aquarium

GALVESTON — Four sharks on display in a popular Galveston aquarium attraction died after the ozone level in the water spiked overnight, officials said.

Divers at Moody Gardens Aquarium tried for almost an hour to revive two of the sharks by injecting them with steroids before declaring them dead with the other pair, said Jerri Hamachek, a spokeswoman for the aquarium.

No other aquarium animals were affected. Ozone is pumped into the tank to kill bacteria and parasites and to clarify the water, but aquarium staff members are unsure why the ozone levels rose to dangerous levels.

"The exhibit has been open for nine years, and we've never had this issue happen before," Hamachek told the Galveston County Daily News.

The sharks, collected in the Gulf of Mexico, were two blacktip sharks, an Atlantic sharpnose shark and a blacknose shark.

## Abandoned Diver Gets Permission to Sue Dive Boat

A Superior County judge has ruled that Daniel Carlock can take to trial his \$4 million lawsuit against Ocean Adventures Dive Co. in Venice Beach and Sundivers Charter for abandoning him in the ocean during an April 2004 dive trip. After getting separated from 20 other divers, Carlock was left in the ocean amid foggy conditions seven miles off Newport Beach while the crew never realized he was missing. Carlock floated for four hours until he was found by a boat of Boy Scouts. He sued for emotional and physical trauma (he developed skin cancer from his bad sunburn) but Ocean Adventures and Sundiver Charters tried to dismiss his case on the grounds that he assumed the risk of being left in the ocean. The case is set for trial on June 9.
